Dear Mr. Hurst,

Here are indeed the photographs I promised to send you. The smaller ones are copies of pictures taken in 1937. Except for the one with the small boy standing in front of "The Plains" (roadside). This was my grand-father and must have been taken at the turn of the century. The lady was probably Mary Elizabeth Jotherson (July 16, 1836 - April 22, 1924) one of the maiden Aunts that raised him. The stone top table is behind my great-Aunt Amelia Weems Jotherson (Sept. 14, 1850 - Feb. 2, 1941) in the living room at "the Plains". The rocking chair in the back corner was made by slaves.

The larger photos were probably taken in 1940-45. The smaller man on the left was my mother's father, Floyd William Curtis at approximately the age of 50. Maybe the vehicles could date it better.

I am also sending some copies of papers that may or may not be of interest to you pertaining to some family history. You may have these, but as we discussed, I would like the photographs returned.

I look forward to meeting you and Mrs. Kerlett in the near future as I would love to see the table

on display. I have enjoyed our telephone conversations and hope this information is useful.
